This exhaustively researched, and well grounded informative course, deals with the effects of ballistic small arms fire on the human body. The course teaches *Students* correct procedures to be utilized, if they have to make written statements, as to their use of *Lethal Force* against a *Hostile* target.

The course also fully explains the fundamentals of bullet efficiency, which is an important area of training. The session also covers terminal ballistics. This course provides valuable insights into the use of, and application of firearms within the *Law Enforcement S.W.A.T.* scenario. This course should be considered as a *Must* for Lawyers representing *Departments* in relation to the disputed lawful use of *Deadly Force* options.

This course teaches core fundamentals with regard to physiological human responses in relation to ballistic dynamics, and their subsequent physical effects.

Included within the syllabus is a concentrated session of the use of force and discussion of relevant case law that covers *Officers* use of force issues.
