## **R.E.C.A.L.L.**

### **SUSPECT AND WITNESS INTERVIEW TECHNIQUES**

The *R.E.C.A.L.L. Investigative Interview* methods have been designed and written to teach ,or support, the existing interview skills of *Law Enforcement Personnel* and *Social Service Providers*. Including such Individuals who are tasked with gaining information / evidence, through joint investigation for *Prosecution / Intelligence* purposes.

This program accurately reflects the absolute need for quality evidence collation and joint investigation skills. The *R.E.C.A.L.L.* system seeks to address this requirement, and support the *Accuracy, Truthfulness, and Integrity* of the evidence presented.

This *Training Program* teaches *Students*, in a practical and effective way, the fundamentals of successful interviewing, and evidence collation. Working in harmony with and support of outside *Agency Personnel* in a manner that enables maximum efficiency and teamwork.

Working as a dual or multiple *Investigation Team* is a skill that has to be practiced and honed. In some cases without proper training, investigations have been hampered or contaminated. This sometimes due through a lack of understanding of each agencies roles. This course covers the *infra structure* of investigative questioning within the interview room itself, and the positioning of Interviewee's.

Experienced *Officers* will also benefit in a practical way by sharpening and honing personal interactive skills, and working in partner related interviews. The *R.E.C.A.L.L.* program also includes training on the profiling of *Potential Suspects*, and identifying their motives for resisting interrogation. It offers a unique opportunity to develop a practical hands on guide to "*Profiling Motives*" of various *Suspects* during interview.

- ◇ This is a 24 / 32 hour, three / four day training program.
- ◇ Students may wear *Uniform* or *Civilian* dress.
- ◇ Note books video cassette, and writing materials are required.
